

Completing Headcount

Please see below some useful information that may assist you in dealing with the changes to 2 year olds. The maximum funding that can be claimed for a 2 year old this term is 15 hours per week.

From the main Headcount screen, you will be able to identify children eligible for 2 year old funding using the funding age column.

The Funding Column may help you identify if the child is eligible for funding via the original 2 year old funding offer or the new working parent entitlement offer.

Original funding offer = **2**

Working parent entitlement offer = **EH**

Please note there are times where both icons will be visible in the Funding column.

Scenario 1 the child was previously accessing the original 2 year old offer and has since turned 3 and is now eligible for 3 & 4 year old extended offer funding.

Scenario 2 the child is eligible for both the original funding offer and working parent entitlement offer and has had both checks carried out. In this situation the original funding offer will take precedence and you will only be able enter funded hours in the Funded/Universal Hours Claimed columns. This scenario will not happen very often.

Editing Headcount for existing children

Existing children eligible for the original 2 year old offer should only have boxes open to update hours in the Funded/Universal Hours Claimed columns.

Adding new children

When adding a new child to your headcount task one of the following scenarios may happen.

Scenario 1 The child is eligible for funding via the original 2 year old offer.

You have added a new child to your task, the task has not yet been submitted, you **must** have a code from a parent/carer or you have ran an assisted application yourself to obtain a code. The child will not show any funding in the funding column at this point.
