What is Prevention - Youth Offending Service (YOS) - intervention?



Our prevention (YOS) team support young people to make positive choices to bring about changes in their behaviour.



Prevention (YOS) is a voluntary intervention for young people aged between 10 years old - 17 years old, with an aim to prevent antisocial behaviour and offending.



The Together for Children prevention (YOS) team aims to prevent young people from entering the criminal justice system.

Interventions include one-to-one support, and can link into other agencies such as Early Help or make referrals to our partners including Youth Drug and Alcohol Project (YDAP) and emotional wellbeing support to name a few!
